RCGA RULES OF GOLE GOVERN ALL PLAY EXCEPT WHEN MODIFIED BY LOCAL RULES

Speed of Play

While all rounds are to be completed within 4 hours and 15 minutes, an overriding priority is that groups with open holes ahead play at a pace that does not cause groups playing behind them to be held up. In that instance. the lead group must either move more guickly or allow the group(s) behind to play through.

Hints to Improve your Speed of Play

1) Limit the search for lost balls to two minutes

2) If your stroke count for a hole reaches double par, pick up your ball and proceed to the next tee.

3) Hit when ready, even if you are not "away".

4) After taking your first putt, continue until you hole out.

5) Gold tees are recommended for use by players with an 8 handicap or lower.

The Course Marshal

The Marshal is primarily responsible for ensuring, ON BEHALF OF YOU AND YOUR FELLOW GOLFERS, that an appropriate speed of play is maintained and course etiquette is observed. His directives MUST be adhered to.

Our course Marshals will follow our 3 strike rule to ensure all groups keep pace so all groups will enjoy their day.

- 1) If your group is slow our Marshal will kindly ask your group to catch up to the group in front of you.
- 2) If your group is not able to catch up to the group in front of you within a reasonable amount of time the Marshal will kindly ask your group to pick up your golf balls and move back into position.
- 3) If your group is still unable to keep pace and is causing the course to slow down our course Marshal will kindly ask your group to exit the course and proceed to the clubhouse.

RCGA RULES OF GOLE GOVERNALL PLAY EXCEPT WHEN MODIFIED BY LOCAL RULES

Local Rules

1) Staked Trees — Free relief no closer to hole and one club-length if staked tree interferes with stance or intended swing.

- 2) Free relief from cart paths, roadways and wood railings on #2, #4, #14, through the green.
- 3) Out-of-bounds is defined by white stakes and fence line bordering the golf course and driving range on the right of holes 1 and 9.

4) Use designated drop zones for #7 and #12 water hazards.

Course Care & Conduct

1) LIABILITY — PLAYERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL EVENTUALITIES OF THEIR GOLF SHOT.

2) Repair ball marks, replace divots and rake bunkers.

3) Keep power carts on cart paths around greens and tee box areas.

4) Alcohol — Must be purchased from Lewis Estates as outside alcohol is not legally permitted as per ALBERTA GAMING AND LIQUOR COMMISSION POLICY 5.15.1.
